It is also an opportunity to share with you the Antonine College 2025 VCE Results, with many excellent and commendable achievements. A significant number of students received excellent individual Study Scores in their subjects and Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) results. The Dux of the College for 2025 has been awarded to **Jayden Sadek** with an **ATAR of 94.75**. This result is fantastic and the College congratulates **Jayden** for his hard work and dedication to his studies. As Dux of the College, Jayden will receive a financial award to contribute to future educational needs.

The second highest ATAR is recognised with the Year 12 *Proxime Accessi*, which is accompanied by a financial award for future educational needs. With an **ATAR of 91.7**, **Ayla Khabbaze** will receive this award. Both Jayden and Ayla will be presented with their awards at the Feast of St Maroun Opening College Mass on Monday 9 February 2026. Special mention to **Leen Mansour** with an ATAR of **91.45** and **James Fakhry** with an ATAR of **91.3**.

We thank Mrs Carmen Fleyfel for her ongoing generous support of these perpetual awards at Antonine College, which were originally offered by Mr Louis Fleyfel OAM, former Honorary Counsel of Lebanon for Melbourne.
